WARNING: NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY AT THE POOL

We promote a family-friendly environment. The following rules and regulations are for the benefit of all members and are enforced as a means to achieve this objective. These rules also ensure the safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities. Parents are asked to review these rules regularly with their children.

Any failure to comply with these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for immediate suspension and/or permanent revocation of the offending member's pool privileges.

Bailey's Grove Pool Club and Bailey's Grove Property Owners Association will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with the use of the pool, pool grounds, or facility or loss or damage to personal property.

POOL HOURS

Adult Swimming (18 and older only)

10:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon

Open Swimming

10:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.

The pool will close when necessary for health and safety reasons, maintenance, and severe weather.

MEMBER OBLIGATIONS

1. Arriving members and guests **MUST** leave membership card at gatehouse window.
2. Children age 12 and under **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or guardian. **PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN CHILDREN.**
3. Memberships are **nontransferable** and **nonrefundable**.
4. Actions that are adverse to the health/safety/enjoyment of the facility by its patrons may result in the loss of pool membership by the offending person or persons.
5. Loss of membership identification card will result in a \$20.00 reissue fee.

GUESTS

1. A member must accompany guests and be present the duration of the guest's stay.
2. Conduct of guests is the direct responsibility of member.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- ➔ Admission to the pool shall be refused for health reasons at the discretion of the staff.
- ➔ No diving. Absolutely no diving permitted!!! Feet first at all times.
- ➔ No running on pool deck.
- ➔ Pool staff may ask members engaging in unruly conduct to leave the pool area. Abusive or offensive language will not be tolerated. All activities must be conducted so as not to constitute a public nuisance.
- ➔ Children and poor swimmers must be accompanied and supervised by a parent. Parents must remain with children at all times.
- ➔ Babies must wear specialized swim diapers when entering the pool. NO DISPOSABLE OR CLOTH DIAPERS ARE PERMITTED IN THE POOL. Diapers are to be changed in locker rooms only and disposed of in proper receptacle.
- ➔ Use of swim toys will be at the discretion of the Pool Manager.
- ➔ Radios and CD/tape players must be operated with headphones.
- ➔ Due to STATE HEALTH DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS, all food must be consumed and stored in the picnic area, with the exception of drinking water.
- ➔ No pets are allowed in the pool area.
- ➔ No glass of any form is allowed on premises.
- ➔ Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on premises.
- ➔ No smoking is allowed on premises.
- ➔ Only authorized personnel are allowed in the pump room.
