

BAILEY'S GROVE POOL CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are for the benefit of all members. These rules have been established to ensure friendly, safe, and sanitary operation of the pool facilities. Parents are requested to caution their children to observe all rules and obey instructions of the lifeguards.

Any failure to comply with these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for immediate suspension and/or permanent revocation of the offending member's privileges by the pool manager or staff.

THE LIFEGUARDS ARE HERE TO PROMOTE SAFETY AND TO RESCUE OR REVIVE IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT. IT IS NOT POSSIBLE FOR ONE OR TWO PERSONS TO WATCH NUMEROUS SWIMMERS INDIVIDUALLY. MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN CHILDREN. PLEASE DO NOT ASSUME "THE LIFEGUARD WILL WATCH."

A. POOL HOURS

Adult Swimming 18yrs and older only

10:00 AM to 12:00 PM

Open Swimming

10:00 AM to 9:00 PM

The pool will be closed when necessary for health and safety reasons, maintenance, inclement weather and when a severe weather notice is issued.

NOTE – There will be one lifeguard on-site. The lifeguard will NOT always be pool side. For your safety signs are displayed stating “No Lifeguard on duty”.

B. MEMBER OBLIGATIONS

1. Arriving members and guests MUST leave membership card at gatehouse window.
2. Children age 12 and under MUST be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
3. Memberships are nontransferable and nonrefundable.
4. Actions that are adverse to the health/safety/enjoyment of the facility by its patrons may result in the nonrefundable loss of membership by the offending person or persons.
5. Loss of membership identification card will result in a \$20.00 reissue fee.

C. GUESTS

1. A member must accompany guests and be present the duration of the guest's stay.
2. There will be a daily fee of \$6.00 per guest to be collected upon arrival.
3. Conduct of guests is the direct responsibility of member.

D. HEALTH AND SAFETY: WE PROMOTE A FAMILY-FRIENDLY ENVIRONMENT. THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE ENFORCED AS MEANS FOR ACHIEVING THIS OBJECTIVE.

1. Bailey's Grove Pool Club and Bailey's Grove Property Owners Association will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with the use of the pool, pool grounds, or facility or loss or damage to personal property.
2. Admission to the pool shall be refused for health reasons at the discretion of the staff.
3. Unruly conduct may result in removal of pool grounds at the request of the staff. Abusive or offensive language will not be tolerated. All activities must be conducted so as not to constitute a public nuisance.
4. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden.

5. Use of swim toys will be at the discretion of the Pool Manager and lifeguards, based on the safety of the swimmers.
6. If your child cannot swim, the accompanying adult must be watching at all times.
7. All babies must wear a specialized swim diaper when entering the pool. NO DISPOSABLE OR CLOTH DIAPERS ARE PERMITTED IN THE POOL. Diapers are to be changed in locker rooms only and disposed of in proper receptacle.
8. Due to STATE HEALTH DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS, all food must be consumed and stored in the picnic area, with the exception of drinking water.
9. No pets will be allowed in the pool area.
10. No glass of any form is allowed on premises. No smoking is allowed on premises.
11. No diving. No running on pool deck.
12. Radios and CD/tape players must be operated with headphones.
13. For your safety, only authorized personnel are allowed in the pump room.
